Originally built in 1924 for the St. Helens and Silver Cedar Shipping Company, (which later became Silver Line Ltd.) by Wm. Doxford and Sons Ltd.

DWT 8075 LBP/BM 375/53 ft

3 Cylinder Doxford Opposed Piston Diesel.

Details are a little scarce, but it is known the ship was sunk by the German raider "Gneisenau" in the north Atlantic on 16th March 1941.
