The “**Kweilin**” 5902 GRT, one of a class of ships built by Taikoo Dock Yard and Engineering Company Ltd., Hong Kong, in 1962 for the China Navigation Company. Fitted with a Taikoo built Doxford 67LBD4 diesel engine developing 4500 BHP, producing a service speed of 14.5 knots. She was the second vessel in the China Navigation Company to bear the name “**Kweilin**”.

The ship was engaged trading mainly within South and Southeast Asia until January 1974, when sold to Rogers & Co., Port Louis, Mauritius and renamed "**Rogers Trader**". In 1982 she was then sold to Pacific International Lines (Pte) Ltd., Singapore and renamed “**Kota Berjaya**”. Finally, after 24 years’ service, in 1986, she was sent for demolition at Gadani Beach by the Jilani Corporation.
