The **Corabank**, clearly showing her versatility as a multi-purpose cargo liner. Originally built in 1973 as **Corabank** , 11405 GRT, on the Tyneside for the iconic Bank Line, was sold by them in 1984 to Peruvian interests who placed her under the Peruvian flag and renamed her **Unicosta**. Three years later, she was resold to Pacific International Lines of Singapore to become their **Kota Berani**. She lasted another six years within their fleet, under Singaporean ownership, before being sent to Alang in India, for demolition, which commenced in 1993.
