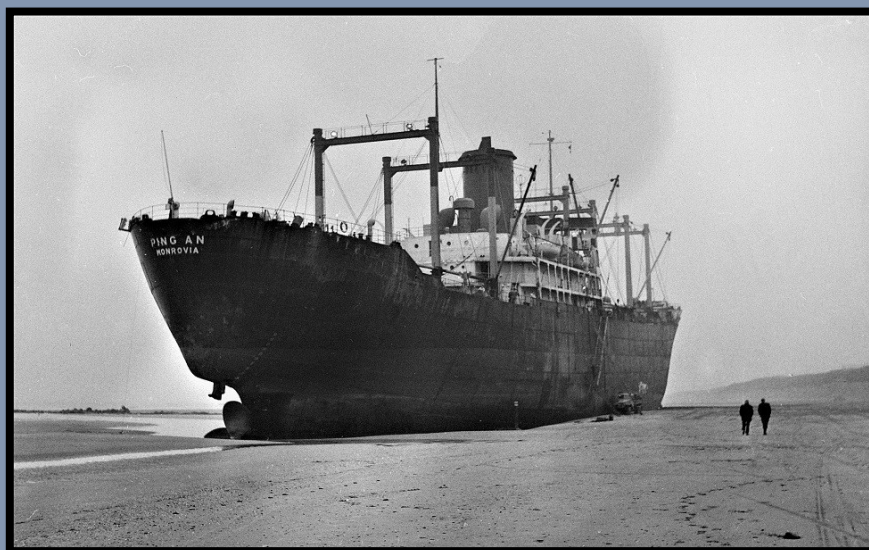

The old Japanese built “goal poster” the “**Ping An**”, Hong Kong owned but Liberian registered, pictured high and dry at Ter Heijde in the Netherlands. She has been driven shore in a severe storm in November 1995, in which I suppose, the loss of her rudder did not help in the least. All 49 crew were rescued by the Dutch Coastguard. The ship was considered unsalvageable and declared a Constructive Total Loss and broken up in situ. It would have been quite a spectacle for early morning strollers on the beach.
