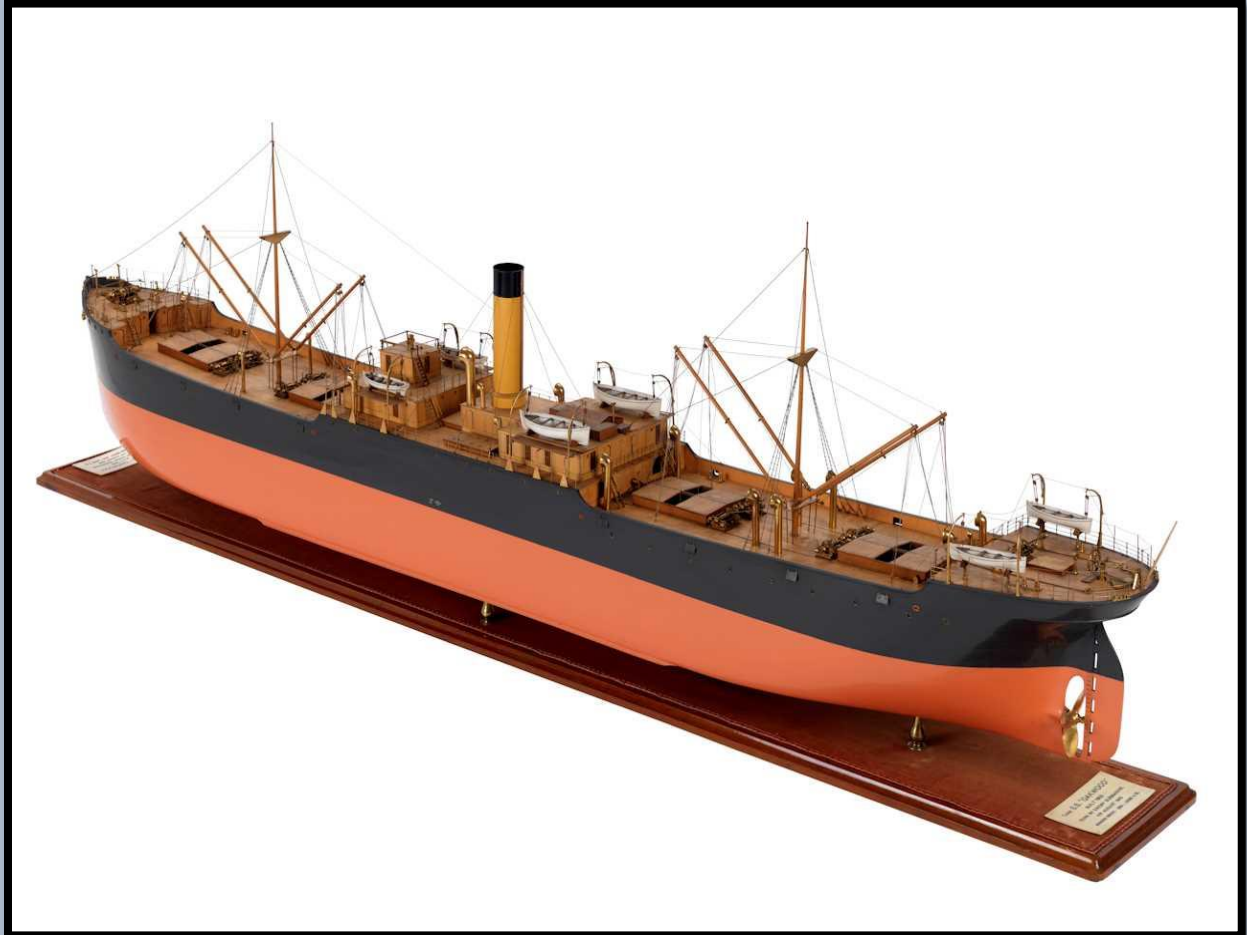


## Fine Model of an Old Steamship



### **SS. Oakwood 1905 - 1915**

Built by Northumberland Shipbuilding Co., Newcastle for J. I. Jacobs & Co.,  
(The Oakwood Steamship Company)

GRT 4275 LOA/BM 110/6.5 m Triple Expansion Engine 372 NHP Speed 12.5 Kts

15<sup>th</sup> Aug 1915 the "Oakwood" whilst on passage from Liverpool to Cienfuegos in Ballast, she was captured by German submarine U-38, and sunk by gunfire when 45 Nautical Miles SSE of the "Old Head of Kinsale". She suffered no casualties.
