Passenger Cargo Ship - MV. Northern Prince

GRT 10,917 LOA/BM 157/20 m Speed 16 Knots

2 x 8 Cylinder SCDA Diesel Engines 2200 NHP Twin Screw

Built by Lithgows Ltd., Glasgow, for Prince Line Limited – James Knott (Royalist SS Co., Ltd.)

Built in 1929 she was a very smart ship for her day. The ship was bombed and sunk by a German JU-88 aircraft in 1941 whilst transiting the Antikithera Channel whilst on a passage from Liverpool to Piraeus, carrying a cargo of Generals and Stores.
