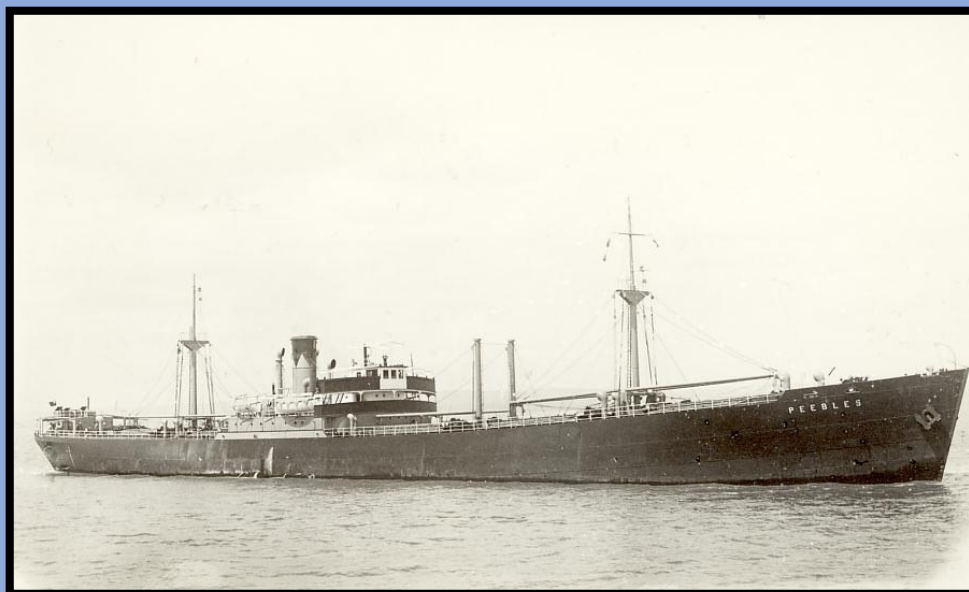

The “**SS Peebles**”, 4982 GRT, built 1936 by William Doxford & Sons Ltd., Pallion, for B. J. Sutherland and Company Ltd., Newcastle. She was fitted with a Doxford Oil 2SA 3cyl Engine, developing, 388 nhp, single screw.

In 1951 she was sold to Westralian Farmers Transport Ltd., London, and renamed “**Swanstream**”. In 1956 sold to China Shipping Co. Ltd., London - John Manners & Co. Ltd., Hong Kong (as managers). In 1957 transferred to San Fernando S.S. Co. S.A., Panama - same managers and renamed “**San Fernando**” and placed under the Panama registry. Sold to Leecho Steamship Company. SA, Panama, Yong & Lee Timber Shipping Co. Ltd., Hong Kong, and renamed “**Phoenician Star**”.

Finally broken up in 1967 at Hong Kong by Leung Yau.
